SUBJECT: 2023 STATE AND FEDERAL INCOME LIMITS

Please find below the 2023 updated income limits effective June 6, 2023 (as per the California Department of Housing and Community Development "HCD") and June 15, 2023 (as per the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development "HUD"). These guidelines are crucial for assessing eligibility in City housing programs funded through state and federal income including the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) and Permanent Local Housing Allocation Program (PLHA).

The charts on the following page detail updated income limits. The "annual income" line displays annual household income levels based on household size, while the "monthly income" line represents the households' gross monthly income before deductions. The "30% of monthly" line indicates the maximum percentage of gross income recommended that households allocate towards rent or mortgage, including utilities, to meet affordability standards.

Note: Housing is considered affordable when rent or mortgage, plus utilities, do not exceed more than 30% of the household's gross income. Households spending 30% or more of their gross income on housing expenses like rent or mortgage and utilities are considered *cost burdened*. Households spending 50% or more are considered *severely cost burdened*.
