Project Background

- Housing Element update process so far
 - Public outreach—multiple meetings and notifications, beginning in 2022
 - Public review draft—9/15/2023
 - HCD review draft

 11/2/2023
 - Public review draft-1/17/2024
 - HCD review letter—1/31/2024
- **Deadline:** Adoption of Housing Element by 12/31/2024
 - Deadline set by HCD



Project Description

- Housing Element update
 - Identify programs and policies to enable the provision of housing in accordance with State law, including the identification of potential sites that could be utilized to meet Regional Housing Needs Allocation
- Zoning Amendments to implement Housing Element Programs
 - Rezoning of necessary sites, as identified in the HE, to accommodate RHNA
 - Includes updates to the zoning map
- Associated General Plan Amendments
 - Land Use Element update for consistency with the Housing Element update and Zoning Amendments
 - Health & Safety Element update to meet the current requirements of State law


- Entirety of Pacific Grove
